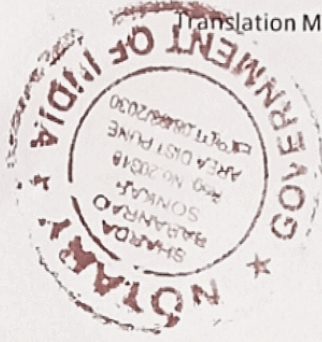




Translation Marathi To English

Regarding the grant of permission for the academic year 2019-20 to establish new schools on a self-financed basis, as well as for the upgradation of existing schools, under the Maharashtra Self-Financed Schools (Establishment and Regulation) Act, 2012.....

Preamble:

1. A proposal for granting recognition to the school, **Mary Memorial International School**, Gat No. 185/1/2, Daund-Patas Road, Girim, Tal. Daund, Dist. Pune, run by the **Indian Society for Social Action**, Pimple Nilakh, Pune, was submitted to the Government. The matter of granting recognition to the said school was under the consideration of the Government.

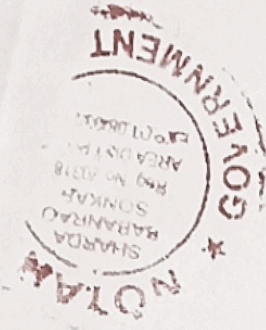
GOVERNMENT RESOLUTION:

2.1. Under the **Maharashtra Self-Financed Schools (Establishment and Regulation) Act, 2012 (Act No. 01 of 2013)**, Government permission is hereby granted to start the new school, **Mary Memorial International School**, Gat No. 185/1/2, Daund-Patas Road, Girim, Tal. Daund, Dist. Pune, run by the **Indian Society for Social Action**, Pimple Nilakh, Pune, (Classes 1st to 10th, Primary to Secondary, English Medium, CBSE) from the academic year **2019-20**, subject to the fulfillment of the following terms and conditions.

2.2 TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

- 1) The concerned Regional Deputy Director of Education must ensure that the institution has not already started the proposed school prior to Government approval. However, if the said school has been started before obtaining Government permission, the concerned Regional Deputy Director of Education shall collect a fine of **Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees One**

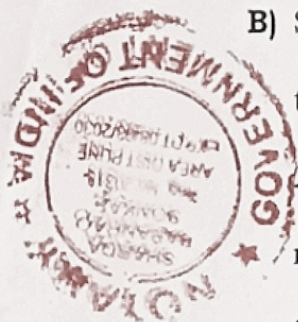
Lakh) from the said school and submit a report to the Government.



(2) The said school is required to fulfill the provisions of the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009, and all the rules/provisions prescribed under it from time to time.

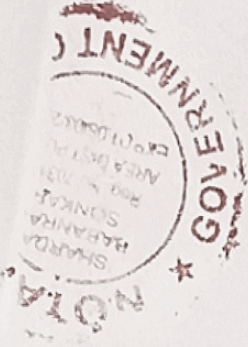
(3) Upon fulfillment of the provisions of the Act, 2009 by the school management, permission (Letter of Intent) is hereby granted to start the school in the academic year 2019-20 as follows:

A) If the management fulfills all the requirements necessary for establishing a school as per the prescribed rules of the Government, the management must apply for the initial recognition to the District Education Officer of the concerned district within one month from the commencement of the academic year.



B) Since the management has been found eligible through this Government Resolution for the year 2019-20, if all the necessary components required to establish the school as per the Government's prescribed rules are not currently available, it will be mandatory for them to fulfill those requirements and start the school within **eighteen months** from the date of this Government Resolution; otherwise, the granted permission shall automatically stand cancelled/void.

C) In accordance with the comprehensive policy prescribed in the Government Resolution dated June 20, 2012, it will be fundamentally mandatory for the school to first obtain **Recognition** in order to secure a No Objection Certificate (N.O.C.) for affiliation with the CBSE Board. After the school receives such Recognition from the District Education Officer (Primary) / District Education Officer (Secondary) /



Education Inspector, Greater Mumbai, in accordance with paragraph (10) of the said Government Resolution, the institution shall apply to the Government along with the recognition letter to obtain a No Objection Certificate (N.O.C.) for board affiliation. After scrutinizing the said application, if the concerned school fulfills the prescribed criteria, terms, and conditions, the Government will issue a No Objection Certificate (N.O.C.) to the school for board affiliation.

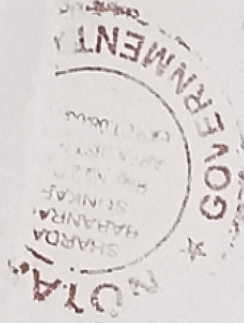
(4) For the newly permitted school, it shall be binding to comply with:

- i) The orders and procedures issued by the Government from time to time, as well as,
- ii) All the provisions of the Maharashtra Self-Financed Schools (Establishment and Regulation) Act, 2012 (Act No. 01 of 2013).

(5) The concerned competent authorities should ensure that the provisions of the Act, 2009 have been fulfilled, and only thereafter proceed with further action regarding granting the initial recognition.

(6) No changes shall be allowed in the future regarding the medium, school location, etc., for which the institution had requested school permission. If the school is started at any place other than the location permitted by the Government, the permission granted by the Government shall automatically be considered cancelled/void.

(7) **U-DISE Data:** While filling out the district-wise information in U-DISE (Unified District Information System for Education) regarding the new schools / upgraded schools permitted through this Government Resolution, it shall be the responsibility of the concerned institution to get registered under a separate category as a "**Permitted School on Self-Financed Basis**" and obtain a U-DISE number. The State Project Director, Maharashtra Prathamik



Shikshan Parishad, Mumbai, has been declared as the Nodal Officer to take further action in this regard. Similarly, for the information of all concerned, the institution must display a public notice board at the entrance outside the school stating: **"New School Permitted on Self-Financed Basis / Upgraded Permitted School"**.

- (8) The recruitment of teaching and non-teaching staff in the permitted self-financed school must be done in accordance with the prevailing rules and policies of the Government.

The concerned Regional Deputy Director of Education shall be responsible for communicating this order to the concerned institution within 15 days.

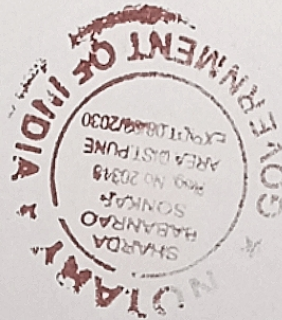
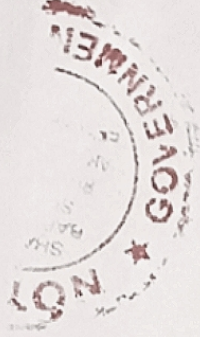

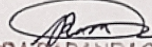
